The BIObec Project

BIObec aims to unlock the full potential of the EU bioeconomy by building bridges between the bio-based industry and the education system, interlinking universities, innovation labs, and R&D centres with industrial actor and regions. The project proposes a holistic framework that merges the traditional idea of an education centre, with that of a knowledge hub. BIObec will establish multi-level Bio-Based Education Centres (BBECs) to act as knowledge hubs bridging the gaps between academic institutions, students, innovation entities and policy makers. Likewise, the BBECs will be flexible enough to answer the actual and future needs of the industry and surrounding ecosystem at local, regional and national levels.

OBJECTIVES

1. To provide a comprehensive understanding of the needs, criteria and conditions for Bio-Based Education Centres (BBECs) to create dynamic ecosystems.
2. To define the most effective design and business models for developing and establishing a BBEC and its educational activities.
3. To provide governance plans, learning programs and feasibility assessments for the proposed BBECs.
4. To provide a roll-out strategy and a roadmap for coordinating the replication of BBECs at European and international level, fostering the outcomes' exploitation and further collaborations.
5. To ensure motivated co-creation, stakeholder involvement, dissemination and communication.
