

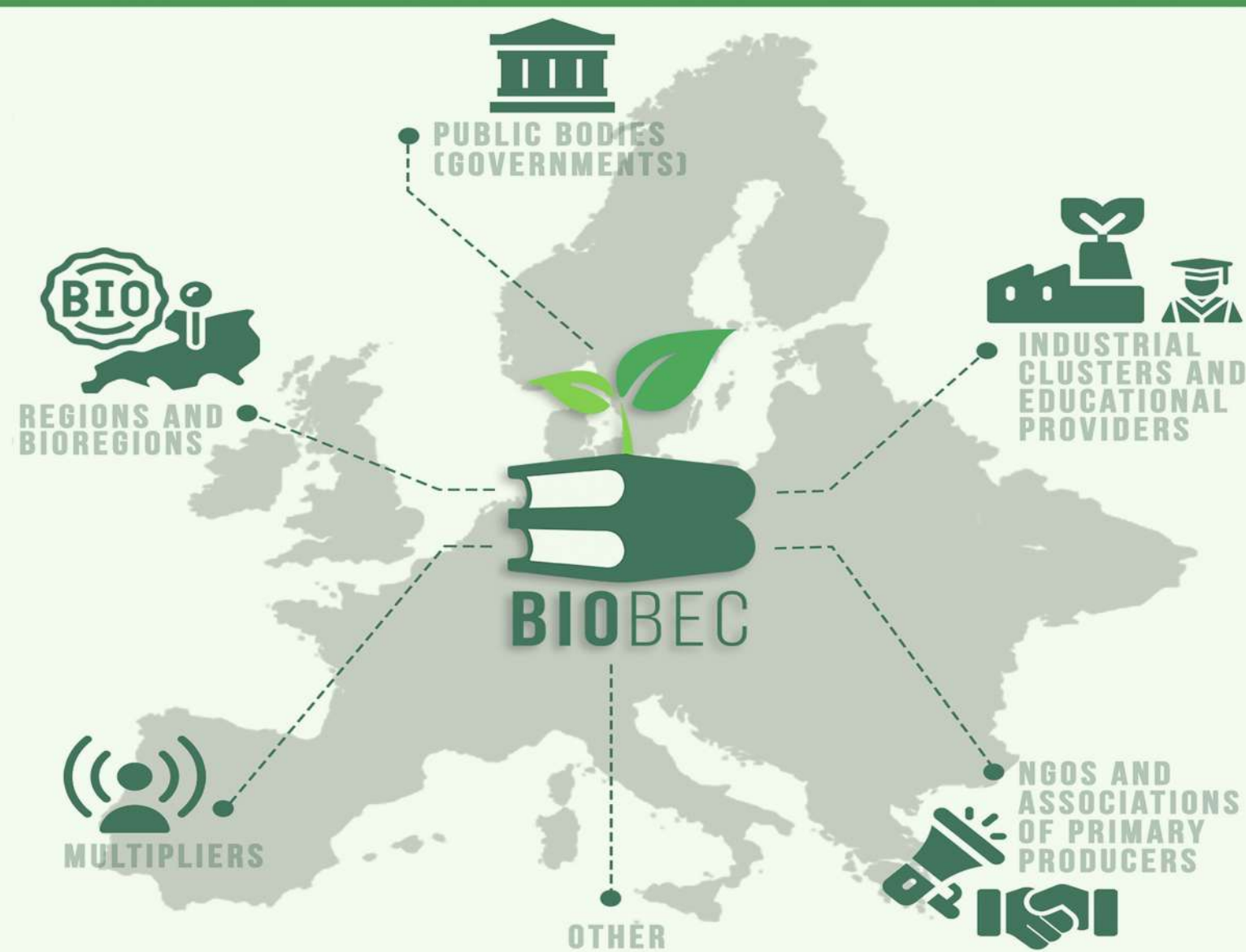
THE BIOBEC PROJECT



BIObec aims to build bridges between the bio-based industry and the education system by interlinking universities, innovation labs, and R&D centres with industrial actors and regions.

The six BBECs: from the same process, different structures

The core of the project is the co-creation process between the partners and the Implementation and Replication Working Group, a group of valuable local stakeholders interested in unlocking the full potential of the bioeconomy.

Through this process, after the assessment of regional needs and expectations and the preliminary definition of elements important for designing the Centres, the BIObec Consortium identified for each BBEC the governance structure, economic and financial requirements, and plans and programs for education and training. The consistency among these three dimensions was fundamental for assessing the feasibility and the sustainability of the 6 BBECs.
